

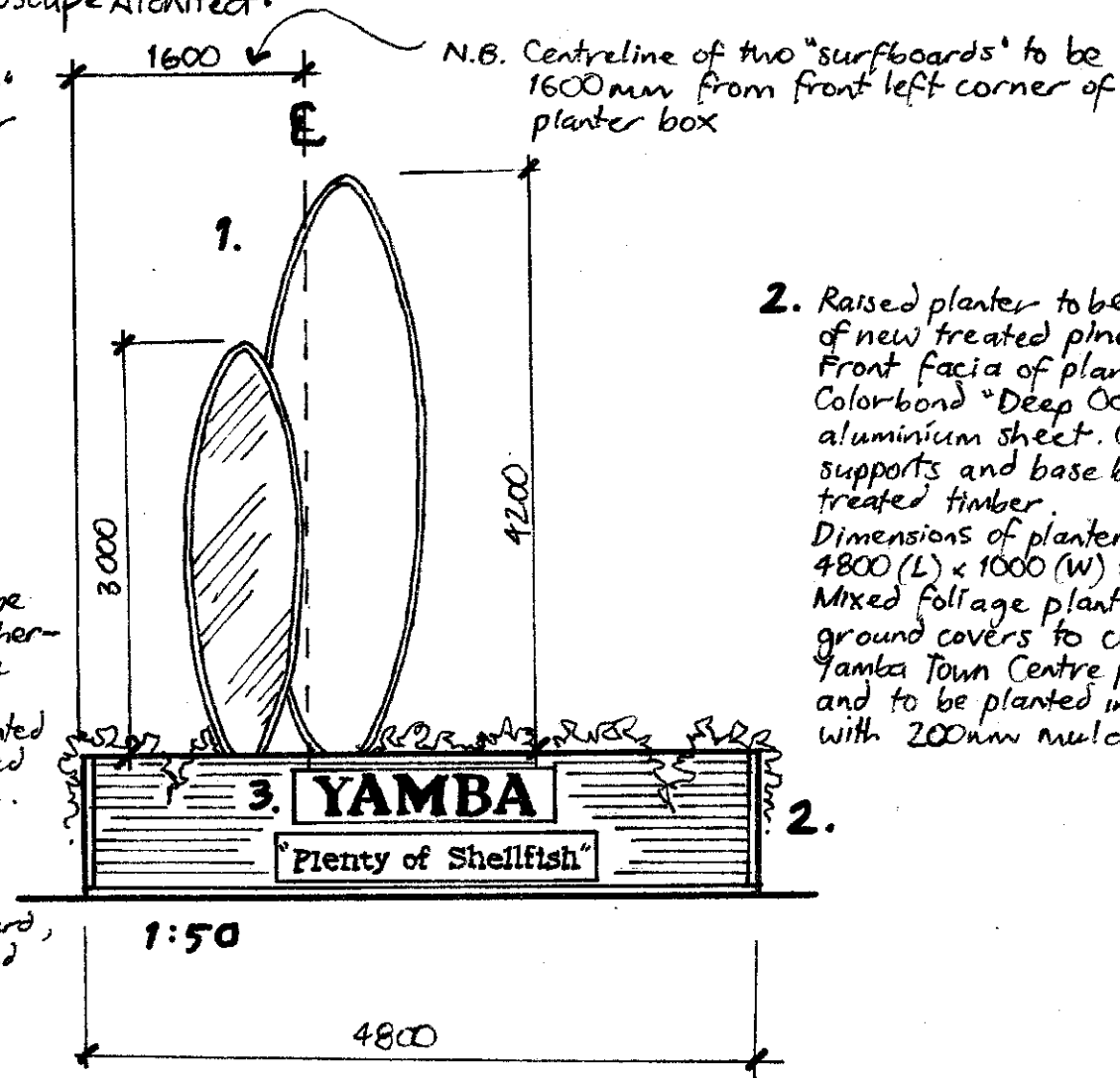
# YAMBA ENTRY SIGN

1. Tubular stainless steel "surfboards" to be mounted in centre of planter box. Shorter, front surfboard to have timber infill panel mounted within frame.

3. 300mm high "YAMBA" lettering (upper case, Cooper Bold font) to be constructed from cut-outs of weather-proof signboard. Finish to be white mosaiced tiles, with mould-proof, dark grey grout. Letters to be mounted on a signboard backboard, painted in "Deep Ocean" Colorbond shade.

75mm high "Plenty of Shellfish" lettering (lower case) to be mounted on weather-proof signboard, painted in "Deep Ocean" Colorbond shade.



2. Raised planter to be constructed of new treated pine slabs. Front fascia of planter to be Colorbond "Deep Ocean" aluminium sheet. Corner upright supports and base board to be treated timber. Dimensions of planter to be: 4800 (L) x 1000 (W) x 1000 (H). Mixed foliage plants and ground covers to complement Yamba Town Centre planting, and to be planted in new soil with 200mm mulch layer.
